

ORDINANCE NO. 09-01

BIRMINGHAM TOWNSHIP
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BIRMINGHAM, COUNTY OF CHESTER, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BIRMINGHAM, CHAPTER 115, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", TO ESTABLISH THE PLACEMENT OF PEDESTRIAN CROSSWALKS AS PROVIDED IN ARTICLE II, SECTION 115-26.1

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Birmingham, County of Chester, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Chapter 115, "Vehicles and Traffic" is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION I. Article II, Section 115-26-1 is hereby amended by establishing pedestrian crosswalks at the following locations.

- A. Meetinghouse Road approximately 989 feet west of Birmingham Road (SR2001), linking the Birmingham Hill Trail on the north and south sides of Meetinghouse Road.
- B. Meetinghouse Road approximately 1,106 feet west of Birmingham Road (SR2001), linking the Birmingham Hill Trail on the north and south sides of Meetinghouse Road.

SECTION II. SEVERABILITY.

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts hereof. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Birmingham that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION III. REPEALER.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION IV. RENUMBERING.

The location and numerical designation of this Article and the Sections included herein shall be delegated to the discretion of General Code Publishers who may renumber these Articles and Sections as are necessary to accommodate these Articles.

SECTION V. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment as provided by law.
