APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the July 21, 2020 HARB meeting were approved, as written, all in favor.

942 STONEY RUN DRIVE:

Susan and Mark Beauchamp submitted an application to replace all the stucco on their house with Hardie Plank siding, color: Cobblestone, which is a light beige. All the trim will be a white azek, and the door will be a dark brown. The shutters will be black. The stone portions of the home will remain untouched.

Mr. Jensen motioned to approve the application. Mr. Garrison seconded the motion; all in favor

The Beauchamps were asked to call the township office tomorrow morning to get a link to the Supervisors' meeting on September 16, 2020.

969 WES MOORE DRIVE:

Daniel and Patricia Warner presented an application to remove the existing stucco and siding from their home and replace it with Hardie Plank siding, color: Arctic White. All the trim will be white as well. The stucco on the chimney will be replaced with stone veneer to match the stone veneer on the home. The shutters will be black raised panels.

The Warners also plan to replace their roof with Certainteed Landmark shingles in "Moire Black".

It was suggested they might consider using louvered shutters on the second floor with raised panel shutters only on the first floor, in keeping with HARB guidelines.

Mr.Jensen motioned to approve the application. Ms. McCarthy seconded the motion; all in favor.

The Warners were asked to call the township office tomorrow morning to get a link for the Supervisors' meeting on September 16, 2020.

REVIEW OF GUIDELINES:

HARB members discussed acceptable materials for use in roofing, siding, decking, trim, windows and shutters. They also discussed roof-mounted solar panels. The amendments to the guidelines will be voted on at next month's meeting.
