Tree Removal

Dog Waste Stations

Mr. Feld has been regularly visiting Sandy Hollow a few times per week and has not noticed any excess trash at the waste station. The Committee feels no action should be taken at this time as the last overflow incident was most likely isolated.

Cutting

Mr. Hicks will cut the field where the Battle will be fought next week so the grass will have about a month to grow back to the desired height. The rest of the park will need to be cut about a week prior to the event.

Wild Hemlock

Mr. Hicks recently went along the woods and mowed an abundance of wild hemlock. Mr. Feld was able to spray the rest and does not feel it should cause any issues as it's only a problem if ingested.

Cannon

The cannon will need to be repainted towards the end of this year.
