Birmingham Hill Update

Hikes with Herrin

Hikes with Herrin was scheduled for the 10th of this month, but was canceled due to inclement weather. District Office Director, Ms. Emily Pisano, will follow up if she plans on rescheduling.

Dead Tree Removal

Mr. Brian Mateszewski submitted a quote for tree removal on Meetinghouse Road. Three trees were identified as needing to be removed, especially a potentially hazardous Sugar

Maple. Mr. Feld plans to get additional removal estimates and will follow up with the group via email rather than waiting for the next RPOS meeting.

Proposed Footpath Extension Along Wylie Road

Majic Landscaping submitted a proposal for mowing a fifteen foot wide path from Wylie Road all the way down to Firethorne Drive. The quote is \$1600 for the year and includes twenty-seven mowings. Trimming the split rail fence two times per month is priced at \$35.

Fence Rails

Mr. Feld informed the group that Birmingham Hill is in need of more fence rails as it is currently running low.

Sandy Hollow Update

RPOS agreed that the recent work day was very efficient and Sandy Hollow is looking much cleaner, along with the walking path as it's now being trimmed. Certain areas still need to be professionally landscaped, so Mr. Feld volunteered to draw up a plan and reach out to landscapers for quotes. Ms. Siemer noted it may be worth looking into applying for a mini grant from the Conservancy next year to cover costs.
